August 12, 2017

Call to Order:

Account Balance:

- Mr. Timpanaro led the meeting by welcoming new members and explaining the Friends of UACHS mission as well as their past accomplishments. He talked about raising \$1,500 at the 15 Year Anniversary party, another \$1,500 at the annual Tricky Tray Raffle event, as well as several hundred dollars from our Applebee's Fundraisers and Krispy Kreme doughnut sales. The current account balance is \$1,938.72 with another \$1,000 on it's way from Kohl's.

New Business:

- Mr. Timpanaro then started with the new business explaining that September 5th is the first day of school and that September 14th is Parent's Night and asked for volunteers for the bake sale.
- David volunteered to head the bake sale and recruit other members for it.
- Mr. Timpanaro also promoted the October 7th Applebee's flapjack fundraiser where UACHS students will be the servers raising money for the school and the Friends of UACHS.
- Mr. Timpanaro then explained our past College and Career Day and asked for ideas for our upcoming one this year.
- Lucille proposed going to St. Peters University or inviting them here as well as visiting other colleges around NJ.
- David works at the hospital and said that he will see if he could get us to partner with them.
- Mr. Timpanaro also suggested working with guidance for College and Career Day. He also suggested adding Service Day to this event and have students travel to colleges or to community aide locations on this day.
- Lucille also mentioned City Harvest as a possible community partner and having an Impact Day of volunteerism. Mr. Timpanaro suggested running that through our up and coming Interact Club via the JC Rotary Club.
- The committee then approved both the parent involvement policy as well as the school-parent compact that was presented with no changes suggested.
- Lucille then suggested having a door prize at our meetings to attempt to get more parents at our meetings as well as making a flyer for parents night.
- Other suggested fundraisers were having a Halloween dance outside of the school possibly at NJCU, having an alumni prom, having movie nights like they have in the park for families, pretzel factory sales, and dance classes.
- Mr. Timpanaro reminded everyone about the school supplies driving that is going on and that we want donations before the first day of school and then announced that the next meeting would be September 9th.
